

Potty Training Policy and Photo Consent Form

Wee Blessings Preschool is a faith-based preschool licensed by the state of Iowa. In accepting younger children (ages 3 and 4) it's important for parents to understand the need for all children in the classroom to be potty trained prior to starting preschool. Your adherence to this policy helps to ensure a positive school experience for your child and all the other children in the classroom.

Your potty-trained child can:

- Tell the teacher he/she needs to go to the bathroom.

- Is able to go to the bathroom (either urinating or bowel movement) on his/her own. This includes removing clothing, sitting on the toilet, wiping, putting clothing back on, flushing and washing his/her hands.

- Is aware of the need to go to the bathroom without reminders from teachers. Teachers WILL provide a designated bathroom break time, and outside of those times the child must be able to tell teachers when he/she needs to go.

- Will not be in diapers or pull-ups at all. He/she must be in regular underwear.

We do not have the staffing to potty train children, and it's important that our teachers are available in the classroom to work with your child on daily classroom activities.
